This past fall, the football program needed a new viewing screen for the camera Hi-Pod system that is used to film games. The coaches were told there was no money to replace the \$300+ screen so they set out to fundraise. Three Central Football alumni saw the coaches Facebook post and took care of purchasing the screen. During the 2021 season, a local business donated \$5,000 to Red **River HS football and nothing to Central Foot**ball. And our school district does not have the funding to take care of these needs. Our group decided to take the initiative to take care of things with our Central Football Alumni. By creating a foundation, our goal is to create something for the long-term instead of just a quick fix.

## 2022 Season Recap

The 2022 team won their first game of the season with a victory over Watford City to begin the season 1-0 for the first time since the 2009 season. The team then faced four teams ranked in the top 5 in the state and unfortunately went 0-4 during that stretch. That did not deter the coaches or players as the team kept working and went 3-1 in the last four games of the regular season to earn a playoff berth. Although the Knights lost to Jamestown in the playoffs to close out the season, it was the first time the team has won at least four games and made the playoffs since the 2007 season. It definitely builds momentum for the 2023 season and beyond with such a strong finish to the season.





#### Meet Head Coach Jake Schauer

On April 7, 2022 Jake Schauer was named the 19th head coach in the history of Central Football. A native of Williston, ND coach went on to attend Valley City State University where he was a four-year football letter winner and Team Captain in 2013. He graduated with a B.S. in Physical Education and Elementary Education,

Coach Schauer began his teaching and coaching career spending five years in Park River, ND. In Park River, Coach Schauer was fortunate enough to be an assistant coach for five state championship winning teams (Football x2, Baseball x3). After Park River, Coach Schauer moved on to Thompson where he spent one year as an assistant coach before being named head coach for the 2020 and 2021 seasons. Coach Schauer served as an assistant coach for the 11-man East Shrine team in 2016.

Jake is a 6th grade teacher at Valley Middle School and his wife, Alyssa, is a Financial Advisor for Edward Jones in Grand Forks. Together, they have two daughters Jordy (5) and Lennyn (1).
